Parental Objections to Specific Course Material

The Board recognizes that there may be specific course materials which some parents/guardians find objectionable.

In the event a parent/guardian finds specific course material objectionable, the parent/guardian may notify the building principal of the specific material to which they object and request that the student receive alternative course materials, sufficient to enable the child to meet state requirements for education in the particular subject area. This notification and request shall be in writing.

The building principal and the parent must mutually agree to the alternative course materials. The alternative course materials agreed upon must meet state minimum standards. Any cost associated with the alternative course materials shall be borne by the parent.

Nothing in this policy shall be construed as giving parents/guardians the right to appeal to the school board.

Parents who wish for particular course materials to be reviewed for appropriateness may submit a request for review in accordance with Board Policy KEC
