

**BARNSTEAD SCHOOL DISTRICT  
Electronic Devices**

The use of cell phones, music CD's, Ipods, MP3-type players (audio and video), cameras, video game players, and other electronic devices may not be used when school is in session. Students may bring these items to school, but must keep the items turned off and kept in their lockers or bags until after the bell sounds to end the school day.

Any student found using or possessing such items on their person will be asked to turn over the item to the teacher or administrator. Such item will be held in the principal's office until the parent/guardian comes to school and it is returned to them.

The school does not accept any liability for the loss, damage, or security of such electronic devices. It is the students' and parents' responsibility to make sure it is in a safe place.

Student use of cameras, digital cameras, cell phones and/or camera phones, video, and/or audio recording devices in school is strictly prohibited without specific permission granted by the administration or the teacher.

Personal computing devices may be used in school with the permission of the Technology Coordinator or Administration. Access to school services (network, printers, etc.) may be restricted for personal devices at the discretion of the Technology Coordinator. Misuse of school resources covers personal devices as well (Policy JICL and JICL-R).
