**Work Study Program**

In order to meet the educational needs of students, a "work study" program may be implemented.

Work study is defined as "an out of school, vocational experience, supervised by school personnel".

Acceptance into an individualized work study program is made by the Student Placement Team, the parent(s), and when appropriate, the student under consideration. The Administration retains final control over the work study program. The purpose of the work study experience varies depending on the educational needs of the particular student. Examples include: integration into the community, specific vocational training, work experience, skill development, motivation and self esteem.

Coordination of the work study is carried out by the student's case manager, with consultation and input by the professional team.
